

## All four Olympic 2024 bid cities through to second stage of bidding process

**All four candidates bidding to host the 2024 Olympics have made it through to the second round of the bid process following an International Olympic Committee (IOC) meeting.**

Chair of the 2024 Games' Evaluation Commission Frank Fredericks, said that "no significant issues were flagged" with the bids lodged by Budapest, Los Angeles, Paris and Rome, and that all four cities had "embraced the Olympic Agenda 2020".

Fredericks commented that the cities have devised a "strategic roadmap" which aligns their Games concept with the long-term development goals of their nations.
